Leviticus 23:34 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, The fifteenth day of this seventh month *shall be* the Feast of ***Tabernacles*** for seven days unto the LORD...

The Feast of the Bra

All 16 references to “FEAST OF TABERNACLES” or “booths” in OT use the singular noun:

5521 hK'su cukkah {sook-kaw'}

Meaning: thicket...(a rude or temporary shelter)

The word “Succuth”, The plural noun is referred to 18 times and always refers to a place never to the Holy Day.

5523 tAKsu Cukkowth {sook-kohth'} **Meaning:** "booths"...

Leviticus 23:39 In the fifteenth day of the seventh month, after you have gathered in the produce of the land, you shall celebrate a Feast unto the LORD...

40 On the first day bring the fruit of the beautiful trees, fronds from the date palms, branches with thick foliage, branches from the willows of the brook; and you will exult and rejoice in the presence of the LORD your God seven days.



The Feast of the Bra

- **Neh 8:14 And they found written in the law ... that the children of Israel should dwell in booths in the feast of the seventh month:**
- **15 ...saying, Go unto the mountain, and gather olive branches, and pine branches, and myrtle branches, and palm branches, and branches of thick trees, to make booths....**

Leviticus 23:42 You shall dwell in booths seven days; all that are Israelites born shall dwell in booths:

43 That your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to dwell in booths, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I *am* the LORD your God.

- *Why is the noun always singular?*
- *Why were the people told to build a branch shelter and exult & rejoice with branches and fruit in the presence Of God?*
- *Why was this FEAST named after a branch shelter rather than tents?*









Phil 2:6 (hp) Who, was in the image of God, but did not seize onto this equality:


7 But emptied himself, and took on the image of a human bond slave:

FRUIT

Lev 23: 40 ...on the first day you will bring the fruit of beautiful trees...

6529 periy {per-ee'}

Meaning: fruit 1a) fruit, produce (of the ground), offspring, children...

Ps 1:3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bears his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither...

Prov 3:9 Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the **firstfruits** ...

Jer 2:33 Israel was holiness unto the LORD, *and* the **firstfruits** of his increase...

FRUIT

Gal 5:22 But the **fruit** of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance

John 15:16 You have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and selected you, that you should go and bring forth **fruit**, and *that* your **fruit** should remain (not perish, endure)...

Rev 14:4 ... These follow the Lamb wherever he goes. These were redeemed from among men, *being* the **firstfruits** unto God and to the Lamb.

BRANCH

5687 `aboth {aw-both'}

Meaning: 1) having interwoven foliage, leafy, dense with foliage

5526 %k;s' cakak {saw-kak'} or %k;f' sakak (Ex 33:22) {saw-kak'}

Meaning: 1) to hedge, fence about, shut in 2) to block, overshadow, screen, stop the approach, shut off, cover, protector, lay over, **to weave together**

The Feast of the Branch

BRANCH

Gen 49:28 All these *are* the twelve **tribes** of Israel...

7626 j̄b,ve shebet {shay'-bet}

Meaning: rod, staff, **branch**, **offshoot**, club, sceptre, tribe...

Is 60:21 Your people also *shall be* all righteous: they shall inherit the land for ever, the **branch** of my planting, the work of my hands, that I may be glorified.

The Feast of the Bra

BRANCH

John 15:1 I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. 2 Every branch in me that does not bear fruit **he takes away**: and every *branch* that bears fruit, he **purges** it, that it may bring forth more fruit... 5 I am the vine, you *are* the branches: He that abides in me, and I in him, the same brings forth much fruit: for without me you can do nothing.

142 ai;rw airo {ah'-ee-ro}

Meaning: 1) to raise up, elevate, lift up ...from the ground...
(*and entwine with who?*)

2508 kaqai, rw kathairo {kath-ah'-ee-ro}

Meaning: 1) to cleanse, of filth impurity, etc 1a) to prune
(*baptize...*)

All covering branches had to die... Perpetuation... through death

BRANCH


Mark 11:8 And many spread their garments in the way: and others cut down branches off the trees, and spread *them* in the way.

9 And they that went before, and they that followed, cried, saying, **Hosanna** (save us!); Blessed *is* he that cometh in the name of the Lord:

Rev 7: 9 After this I observed a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and ***palms in their hands***;

10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.

Meaning: to hedge ... to block, overshadow, screen, stop the approach... cover, protector...weave together

DEFENSE

Job 1:10 Have you not made a **hedge** about him, and about his house, and about all that he has on every side?

Is 60:18 ...but you shall call your **walls** Salvation, (Yeshua) and your gates Praise.


TREE OF LIFE

Revelation 22:1 And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.
